

2024 Scholarship Eligibility and Requirements

What is the J. Mitchell Ellington Scholarship?

This scholarship program is named after Mitch Ellington, a founding father of our organization who passed away on October 10, 1995. Mitch had started this program with the intention of presenting it to goal-oriented, hard-working students whose grades may not reflect the students' effort and dedication.

What is the Joseph G. Weber Scholarship?

This scholarship is named after Joseph Weber who passed away on February 20, 2024. Joe joined the NUCA of Central Florida's Board of Directors in 1989 and had been a guiding force in our chapter ever since. "Sr" served on the Board every year and was our Chapter President in 1993, 2010 and 2011. Our chapter had also been very fortunate to have had Joe Weber represent us on the board of UUCF/NUCA of Florida for 18 years. Joe had a strong sense of service not only to our industry, but also to his church and community. This scholarship is intended to honor Joe and his commitment to service.

Who may apply?

Any child of a NUCA of Central Florida member or of an employee of a member who will be enrolled full- or part-time in an academic institution beginning in the Fall of 2024. This may be a four-year or two-year college, as well as a construction industry trade or technical school. *New students, as well as returning students are encouraged to apply.*

How will the application be judged?

Each application will be evaluated for both the Ellington and Weber scholarships – only one application is required. Selections will be based on the general worthiness of the application, including:

- Scholastic Standing
- Activities/community service
- Career goals

- Past employment
- Essay
- Thoroughness of completed application

How will the confidentiality of the application be protected?

When the application is received by NUCA of Central Florida, each application will be numbered and the first page of the application will be placed in a sealed envelope marked with a number of the application. The Scholarship Committee will review the application (with no knowledge of the name, address, etc. of the applicants). Once a selection has been made, only the winners will be identified.

What must accompany the application?

1. Transcript of high school grades through the latest grading period available (may be Fall 2023).

2. *Students* must include a letter of recommendation from a faculty member. The letter should include the number of students in the graduating class and the standing of the applicant. Working applicants must include a letter of recommendation from their employer.
